Payment Plan Available:

The 2010-2011 season ends in early March with flexible practice & meet schedules. Practices will be available at least five days most weeks. You choose the practice days and meets!

SJA swimmers will be divided into five groups based on ability levels with fees ranging from \$250 for the beginning group to \$450 for the most advanced group. The most advanced group will practice from 5:00-7:30, and the beginning and intermediate groups will practice from 6:30-7:30.

Additional Costs: \$55 USA Swimming fee (insurance and state registration) and 10% fee for SJPS pool usage fee. (\$225 off-season high school swimmers)
