



St. Joseph High School / 2016 - 2017 Spring Semester Early College Course Offerings

The following courses are available for college credit through a partnership with St. Joseph High School and Lake Michigan College. This program is offered at St. Joseph High School during the Spring Semester:

Students interested in earning college credit must complete the following steps:

1. Check prerequisites for the courses you wish to take.

If the prerequisites list E, M, or R you must meet our college level English (E), Reading (R) and/or *Math (M) proficiencies. Please check prerequisite descriptions for each class. Please review the chart below for acceptable minimum test scores. *Some courses require higher level math courses and higher test scores may be required beyond the minimums listed here.

2. Discuss billing arrangements with your High School or Tech Center.

Please speak with your High School Guidance Counselor or Tech Center Office to discuss payment policies. For high school payments, a billing authorization signature is required to bill for tuition and fees. Registrations will not be accepted or processed without a billing authorization signature or other form of payment at time of registration (check or money order for payment in full is required for any self-pay registrations).

3. Complete the Early College registration form. Attach applicable test scores.

Registrations must be signed by the student, parent and school district. Be sure to confirm that the correct CRNs are listed and all course information is complete. Incomplete registrations will not be processed.

4. Submit the completed Early College Registration & Authorization form to the Guidance Office by **3/6/2017.**

5. Confirm course registration using your LMC student WaveLink account.

Once your form has been processed, you will be able to view your college schedule on your LMC WaveLink student account. Please allow time for processing this form in order for your schedule to be listed online. First time students will not have WaveLink access until registration is completed.

6. Classes taken for college credit will be recorded on a permanent college transcript.

Unofficial transcripts, schedules, and registration history can be accessed through WaveLink. To request an official transcript, please use the Official Transcripts link within WaveLink. There is a fee associated with sending official transcripts. Please note that you will not receive college credit for a course unless you register (even if you sit through the course). We do not grant retroactive credit.

7. Drop / Withdrawal Procedure.

The official Early College Drop/Add/Withdraw Form must be completed and submitted to the Early College Office at Lake Michigan College for a class to be dropped or withdrawn from enrollment by the deadline. If a student does not follow the college's drop or withdrawal procedure, he/she will receive an 'E' grade on his/her college transcript. Withdrawing from or failing college classes may cause a student to be ineligible for Federal Financial Aid after graduation.
