Spring Semester Early College Course Offerings

The following courses are available for college credit through a partnership with St. Joseph High School and Lake Michigan College. This program is offered at St. Joseph High School during the Spring Semester:

Students interested in earning college credit must complete the following steps:

- 1. Check prerequisites for the courses you wish to take and submit acceptable ACT, SAT, Asset or Compass scores with your registration.** Must meet E (English), R (Reading) and/or *M (Math) score requirements on the ACT, SAT, Asset or Compass assessment as outlined in prerequisite descriptions for each class. Proof of acceptable scores must be received on an Official Score Report or Sticker Labels are required for processing. The below scores meet the minimum prerequisite standards. Higher level math courses or their equivalent competency levels as demonstrated with higher assessment scores may be required beyond the minimums listed here. Not all classes will require all three subject areas.

Qualifying MINIMUM scores for Early College are:

ACT: **E** (English)- 18, **R** (Reading)- 17, ***M** (Math)- 18

SAT: **E** (Writing/English) and **R** (Reading)- Verbal 490, ***M** (Math)- Quantitative Score 440

Asset: **E** (Writing/English)- 44, **R** (Reading)- 11.8, ***M** (Math)- 41

Compass: **E** (Writing/English)- 78, **R** (Reading)- 78, ***M** (Math, Pre-Algebra)- 46

NOTE: Students may take the Compass assessment a maximum of twice per semester. Please study prior to taking the assessment. Review materials can be found at www.lakemichigancollege.edu/assessment ; click on the Assessment Services tab.

- 2. Discuss billing arrangements with your High School or Tech Center.**
Please speak with your High School Guidance Counselor or Tech Center Office staff to discuss payment policies. For high school payments, a billing authorization signature is required to bill for tuition and fees. Registrations WILL NOT be accepted or processed without a billing authorization signature or other form of payment at time of registration. Students may be responsible for the cost of textbooks. Please check with your high school
- 3. Complete the Early College registration form.**
Registrations MUST be signed by the student, parent and school district. Be sure to confirm that the correct CRNs are listed and all course information is complete (including credits, contact hours and dual credit information). Incomplete registrations WILL NOT be processed.
- 4. Submit the completed Early College Registration & Authorization form to the Guidance Office by 3/3/2016 .**
